





The CMA credential

The CMA Program

The CMA Program is designed to help candidates learn and master critical concepts in the management accounting field. It is composed of 2 parts: Financial Reporting, Planning, Performance and Control and Financial Decision Making. The first part encompasses the following topics: External Financial Reporting Decisions (15%), Planning Budgeting and Forecasting (30%), Performance Management (20%), Cost Management (20%), Internal Controls (15%). The second part consists of the following topics: Financial Statement Analysis (25%), Corporate Finance (20%), Decision Analysis (20%), Risk Management (10%), Investment Decisions (15%), and Professional Ethics (10%).

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university or a related professional certification.
- Two continuous years of professional experience in management accounting or financial management.
- File an Exam Registration Form selecting the exam(s)
- Receive a Registration Acknowledgment Form
- Schedule your exam appointment(s) with Prometric.
- Appear for your scheduled exam appointment(s) with the required identification documents.
- Abide by The IMA's Statement of Ethical Professional Practice.

Exam Sessions

Exams are offered on appointment during the below periods:

- January and February
- May and June
- September and October

Exam Process

There are 100 multiple choice questions and two 30-minute essay questions. Candidates have 3 hours to complete the multiple choice section and one hour to complete essays. The essays will be presented to candidates after completion of the multiple choice section of the exam or after 3 hours, whichever comes first. Candidates will note receive immediate pass/fail results because the essay questions will be graded off-line. The score for the multiple choice section will be added to the scores of the essay section for a total weighted score of pass/fail. Candidates cannot take the exam more than once during a testing window.
